

Materials List: Figure Drawing

1. 18x24 pad of Canson or Strathmore, medium-tooth, 70-90 lb. Drawing paper (any good quality, medium-tooth drawing paper will do, lightweight, sketch paper is discouraged)
2. A sheet or two of Medium value toned Paper (towards the 5th and 6th week).
3. A drawing board and clips (Binder clips from an office supply work great, not the tiny ones)
4. F, HB, 2B, and 4B Graphite pencils
5. A graphite stick, B or 2B
6. A couple of pieces of white chalk
7. A Box of 25 soft Vine Charcoal sticks
8. A kneadable eraser
9. A white Vinyl, non-abrasive pencil eraser
10. Several sheets of 150 grit Sandpaper or a fine sanding sponge
11. A knife or razor blade for sharpening
12. a three foot length of string with a weight on the end of it
13. an old long handled artists' brush, willow branch, or length of coat hanger about a foot long
14. a small mirror
15. A charcoal holder is suggested.
